



Introduction to Printmaking

Working with a variety of materials, students will design and assemble a multilayered and textured collagraph plate to create a series of prints. Students will explore shape, texture, and line while learning printmaking techniques and experimenting with mixed media.

Grades: 1 to 5

Curriculum Connections: Visual Arts, Science and Math

Introduction to Lino

Discover the tools and techniques of relief printmaking. Students will explore elements of design while carving a soft linoleum block that will be used to create their own prints. Students will take home finished prints and their carved blocks.

Grades: 6 to 12 Curriculum

Relief Painting

Explore the elements of art and watch how shape, form, texture, and colour come together. Students will create a layered relief painting inspired by landscapes and cityscapes while learning about colour mixing and the basic principles of perspective.

Grades: 1 to 6 Curriculum

Symmetrical Painting

Learn step-by-step instructions to create a symmetrical image that is then translated into a mixed media/watercolour painting. The subject of the painting can be insects, animals (lion or tiger) or inanimate object (space shuttle) ... or an Indigenous Mask / Totem Pole.

Grades: 4 to 8 Curriculum

Curriculum Connection: Visual Arts, Science and Math

Make a Bridge

Using a variety of mixed media materials, each participant will construct and assemble a working bridge! Participants will examine the principles of weight distribution and the importance of balanced forces.

Grades: Kindergarten and up (will be simplified for younger age range)

Curriculum: Science, Math and Visual Arts

Make a free form standing structure (think Eiffel Tower)

Using the "A" frame, participants will have the opportunity to create a miniature model of the Eiffel Tower (inspired). Learn how the famous structure was created while having fun!

Grades: 1 to 8 Curriculum

Curriculum: Science, Math and Visual Arts

Make a Farm/Habitat

Using cardboard and mixed media materials, each participant will build and create a farm building structure. Once created, the students will paint it up and have fun adding additional themed art creations...from making a garden to creating a bench!

Grades: Kindergarten to Three Curriculum
